Northeast Passage (NEP) is a leading provider of Adaptive Sports and Recreational Therapy programs in New England. In 2024, NEP harnessed the power of sports and recreation to enhance the lives of more than 8,700 individuals, including people with disabilities, veterans, seniors, and schoolaged children. A largely self-funded program within the University of New Hampshire's College of Health and Human Services, NEP operates as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit under the University of New Hampshire Foundation.

CLINICAL RECREATIONAL THERAPY

NEP Recreational Therapy (RT) services support the health and wellbeing of individuals with a variety of disabilities and health conditions. Our nationally certified and NH licensed recreational therapists (CTRS/L) work with clients in schools and communities leveraging client interests and strengths, to achieve personal goals.



ADAPTED RECREATION

The Adapted Recreation program offers a spectrum of service, from entry-level instruction and ongoing recreational events, to adaptive equipment rental and personalized consultation. NEP offers recreational opportunities in sports like archery, cycling, golf, water skiing, hiking, ice skating, kayaking, pickleball, wheelchair court sports, and more.



COMPETITIVE SPORTS

The Northeast Passage Competitive Sports program offers competitive team sports for youth and adults with disabilities. Athletes from beginner to developmental and elite levels have opportunities to practice, train, compete, and travel with their teams. Sports currently offered include: Power Soccer, Sled Hockey, Wheelchair Lacrosse, and Wheelchair Rugby.



VETERAN PROGRAMS

Northeast Passage's Veteran Adaptive Sports & Recreation program offers local participation in popular activities aimed at increasing fitness, decreasing the impact of disability and offering healthy, supportive social settings. Programs for Veterans include archery, bowling, cycling, fly fishing, kayaking, snowshoeing, woodcarving, arts and more.

THE (603) CHALLENGE

University-wide online fundraising campaign taking place over five days. Northeast Passage competes against other University programs for bonus funds based on the highest number of individual donors. Donors are incentivized with matches and bonuses added to their gift based on available funds provided by underwriters.

COMP SPORTS CHALLENGE

A month-long peer-to-peer fundraising campaign supporting NEP Competitive Sports Programs, which include Power Soccer, Sled Hockey, Wheelchair Rugby and Wheelchair Lacrosse. Northeast Passage athletes raise money for their respective teams/programs through a P2P fundraising platform. Teams can unlock bonuses from underwriters by hitting targets for income or team participation.

VETERAN STRIPER DAY

A unique a event where local fisherman volunteer their time, expertise, and vessels to take military veterans out for a day of striped bass fishing. The event is based out of the Safe Harbor Wentworth Marina in New Castle, NH. Veteran Striper Day provides the opportunity for veterans to create a memory of a lifetime fishing for New England's most sought after saltwater gamefish. Underwriter contributions support veteran programs throughout the year.
